1. Per reference (a), IT2 (SW) Douglas M. McPeek, is hereby nominated for consideration as War Fighter of the Month for May 2010. Information below is only for the month for which he or she is being nominated.

d. Significant professional achievements:

(1) Job Performance: Critical in the successful S6 turnover with NMCB 22. Without the benefit of additional admin personnel due to delayed party, he expertly and in a timely manner processed a phenomenal amount of work in a short timeframe: he conducted site security surveys of communications space to ensure spaces comply with standards set within standards of the 86th Army Signal Battalion; wrote 10 S6 documents essential for turnover of S6 Communications assets and EKMS responsibilities; responded to and have resolved over 200 network and user trouble calls; activated over 150 network user accounts on the 86th Army Signal Battalion SIPR and NIPR networks. Expertly coordinates daily with Army network support personnel to maintain network connectivity for NMCB 21 users. With his resourcefulness he coordinated the repair of a listed as non-repairable plotter saving the Navy \$10,000 and found an

on-base repair facility for repairing damaged network printers saving the Navy another \$1,000 in costs for acquiring new printer assets. His accuracy in resolving network related issues has provided NMCB-21 with consistent networking capabilities. He has created separate electronic folders for each department for storage of critical information to be share securely within users departments.

(2) Leadership: IT2 McPeek is in charge of all computer/network related issues and assets that reside on the 86th Army Signal Battalion's network supporting the NMCB 21 Battalion. He coordinates all work efforts for a team of 3 additional members of the NMCB 21 S6 Shop without waiver, and has assumed responsibilities of EKMS Manager for the S6 Shop, administering monthly EKMS training to ensure proper protocol is adhered to by all within the Battalion. Dynamic Mentor, IT2 is extremely helpful and attentive, he provides daily guidance on project tasks, computer/network guidance to NMCB 21 personnel to streamline workload performance.

(3) Military Bearing: PFA fall 2009 Excellent / Low. Member is always early to work and stays late to complete tasks ahead of schedule. Uniform, DUU and PT, always in excellent condition and adheres to, and promotes navy core values.

g. Community, Command involvement: IT2 McPeek is currently working with CNET to obtain PQS documentation for the newly implemented Information Dominance Warfare Pin. He has begun to research and document training requirements to implement for training of NMCB 21 S6 personnel and other S6 units. While serving stateside, he volunteers his time as Head Coach to the South Parkland Youth Association's Baseball teams, coaching in the Spring and Fall baseball seasons, and spends numerous hours weekly volunteering as Cubmaster of Cub Scout Pack 72 in Fogelsville, PA, which he serves as a role model to over 90 boys and 20 adult leaders.

3. Other appropriate information to distinguish nominee:

Honor, Courage, Commitment are the words that come to mind when asked about IT2 McPeek. He stands above his peers after a 9 year break in service always maintaining military discipline

in all that he does. Motivated, hard-charging, IT2(SW) McPeek is nothing less than impressive and the clear choice for War Fighter of the Month. Critical to the success of the battalion's mission as well as Task Force Alliance, he is the one behind the scenes who makes things happen, he has had a significant impact on the Battalion every day. Maintaining the Battalion's computer network is an essential position to the Battalion that always seems to be overlooked. IT2(SW) McPeek has my highest recommendation for War Fighter of the Month.
